Certificate of Smoke Detector and Carbon Monoxide Alarm Compliance

- () Smoke detector is located on each level of the dwelling, including basement, but excluding attic or crawl spaces
- () Smoke detector and carbon monoxide alarm is placed outside each separate sleeping area and within ten (10) feet of bedrooms.
- () All smoke detectors are in working order
- () All carbon monoxide alarms are in working order
- () All fire extinguishers are mounted in the proper locations

*Note: All boxes must be checked for certification to be valid.

An inspection shall be constructed by the owner or an authorized representative of the owner. The smoke detectors required above shall be located in accordance with NFIPA-74. The carbon monoxide alarms shall be installed per NFPA-720. The detectors are not required to be interconnected. Battery powered detectors and alarms are acceptable. Note: AC powered and/or interconnected alarms and smoke detectors installed in homes constructed after January 1997 shall be maintained in working order. See attached diagram for further information regarding installation.

**Smoke detector certificates are valid for six (6) months.
