Guttenberg Arts 2nd Annual Members Exhibition

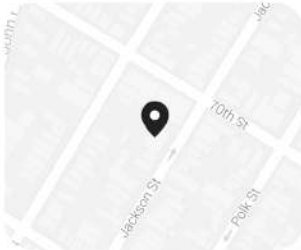
