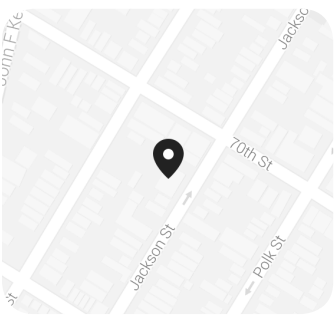

Guttenberg Arts Gallery is pleased to present *Biomorphik*, an exhibition of work by artist **Robert Lach**. On view from March 6th - March 28th, 2021 at the Guttenberg Arts Gallery. To promote social distancing Guttenberg Arts is now open by appointment only and virtually on their website. Robert Lach's sculptures are based on the architecture and anatomy of nature. **Lach** constructs green habitats that reference the design, form and structure patterns found in the natural world. The focus is on the labor of craft by experimenting and manipulating everyday recycled objects into art material. Sculptures are constructed into units or multiples mimicking the biology of living organisms.

Born and raised in Northern New Jersey, **Lach** is a multidisciplinary artist who graduated from **New Jersey City University** with a BFA in sculpture. The local landscape inspires and fuels his art practice – from the state's post-industrial north to the beauty of its southern wildlife areas and beaches. Found objects, recycled materials, and gathered detritus from various environments are muse for sculpture, photography, installation, and public art projects. Public art projects have included the **Atlantic sculpture park** in Atlantic City and **The Gateway Project** in Newark, NJ. The artist has participated in residencies at **Guttenberg Arts, Elsewhere** in Greenboro, NC, **ESKFF** at **Mana Contemporary** in Jersey City, NJ, **Solo(s) Project House** in Newark, and **I-Park** in CT.
